Schedule for day (will be finalized closer to the date):

Class Arrival: 9:30 – 9:45am

Day will involve students participating in at least four organized activities

- Yukon Dan (1/2 hour)
- Stump the Geologist (1/2 hour)
- Mineral Display (1/2 hour)
- Treasure Hunt (1 ½ hours)
- A lunch break of a ½ hour is scheduled.

KEG requires:

- Class size
- T-shirt size for all students and teacher
- Class list (for name tags – only first names displayed on tags)
- Class need to provide at least 1 parent helper for every 5-6 children.
- Class needs to be organized into groups of 5-6 children to participate in the scheduled activities. These groups need to be assigned prior to the conference.
- Class to be learning about geology before the conference.
- Class to provide a display (see sample photos). This display will be setup for the duration of the conference. *Background: The display gives the industry a chance to see that the student participants are learning about geology and mining related subjects, which in turns helps KEG acquire the funding/donations to run the program.*
- Permission slips for photos to be taken on the conference day (need to know if any issues)
- Class to provide their own transportation to and from venue site
- Students in each class need to bring one rock each for the “Stump-the- Geologist” activity.

KEG will provide:

- Foam board for class display
- Table and wall space for display
- KEG will have volunteers to chaperone students and parent volunteers
- Name tags
- T-shirts
