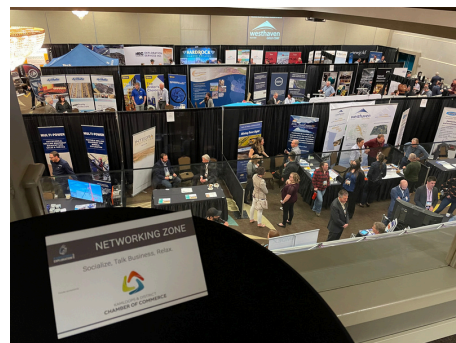
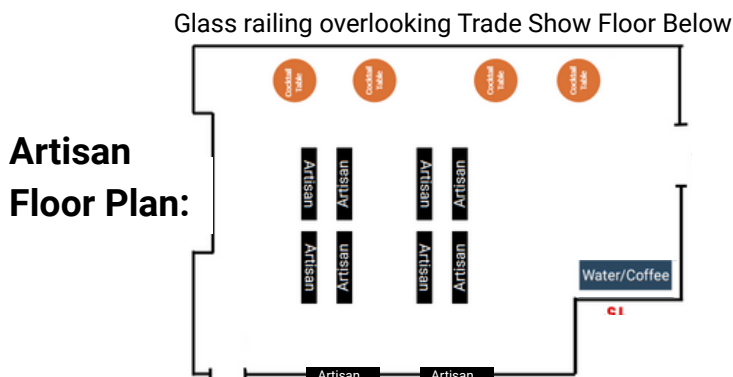

Artisan Terms & Conditions

1. Eligibility & Products

- Exhibitors must sell handmade, original, or artisan-produced items.
- All products must be accurately represented in the application.
- The sale of mass-produced, imported, or resale items is not permitted unless expressly approved in writing by the Organizer.
- The Organizer reserves the right to remove any items deemed inconsistent with the event's purpose or standards.

2. Application Approval

- Submission of an application does not guarantee acceptance.
- Acceptance is at the sole discretion of the Organizer.
- Preference may be given to artisans whose work aligns with the event theme or audience.
- The Organizer reserves the right to limit the number of exhibitors offering similar products.

3. Fees & Payment

- Display fees must be paid in full by the stated deadline to secure space.
- All fees are non-refundable, unless otherwise stated in writing.
- Failure to submit payment by the deadline may result in forfeiture of space.

4. Display Space Assignment

- Display spaces are assigned by the Organizer.
- Exhibitors may request preferred locations, but placement is not guaranteed.
- Display space sharing or subletting is not permitted without prior written approval.

5. Setup & Tear-Down

- Exhibitors must adhere to assigned setup and tear-down times.
- Early tear-down or late setup is not permitted without approval.
- Exhibitors must fully vacate the space by the designated time at event close.

6. Display & Conduct

- Displays must remain within the assigned booth footprint.
- Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their area clean, safe, and professional.
- Noise-producing devices, open flames, or hazardous materials are prohibited.
- Exhibitors must conduct themselves in a respectful and professional manner at all times.

Artisan Terms & Conditions - Continued

7. Sales, Taxes & Licensing

- Exhibitors are responsible for all required business licenses, permits, and tax collection.
- The Organizer is not responsible for exhibitor compliance with local, provincial/state, or federal regulations.

8. Insurance & Liability

- Exhibitors participate at their own risk.
- The Organizer is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to exhibitor property.
- Exhibitors agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Organizer, venue, and event partners from any claims arising from participation.

9. Cancellations & No-Shows

- Exhibitors who cancel or fail to attend forfeit all fees paid.
- No refunds will be issued for no-shows, late arrivals, or early departures.

10. Event Changes or Cancellation

- The Organizer reserves the right to modify event dates, times, or layout as required.
- In the event of cancellation due to circumstances beyond control (including weather, venue issues, or force majeure), the Organizer is not liable for exhibitor losses.

11. Health, Safety & Compliance

- Exhibitors must comply with all venue rules and local health and safety regulations.
- Unsafe or non-compliant displays may be removed at the exhibitor's expense.

12. Marketing & Photography

- The Organizer may photograph or video the event and exhibitor displays for promotional purposes.
- Participation constitutes consent for use of images without compensation.

13. Agreement Acceptance

- By submitting an application and/or participating in the event, the exhibitor acknowledges they have read, understood, and agreed to these Terms & Conditions.
