Dr. Philip Currie

Philip J. Currie is a Professor at the University of Alberta. He has published more than 350 scientific articles, 175 popular articles and twenty books. Fieldwork connected with his research has been concentrated in Alberta, Argentina, British Columbia, China, Mongolia, and the Arctic and Antarctica. Awards include The Alberta Order of Excellence (2010), The Explorers Club Medal (2012), the Royal Canadian Geographical Society Gold Medal (2012), and Romer/Simpson Medal of the Society of Vertebrate Paleontology (2017) the Roy Chapman Andrews Society Distinguished Explorer's Award (2022). In 2015, he was deeply honoured by the opening of the Philip J. Currie Dinosaur Museum in Alberta. He has supervised or co-supervised more than 30 MSc and PhD students. He has given hundreds of popular and scientific lectures on dinosaurs all over the world, and is often interviewed by the press.
