

Update on the Shovelnose Gold Project, South-Central BC. South Zone and Beyond

Westhaven Gold Corp. is currently exploring the Shovelnose Gold Project, a 17,000 hectare property located 30km south of Merritt, B.C. This project covers a number of epithermal gold showings hosted in mid-Cretaceous felsic and intermediate volcanics of the Spences Bridge Group, which comprises a 110-kilometre long northwest trending belt formed in a continental arc setting (“Spence Bridge Gold Belt”). The project has seen a long history of exploration going back to 2005 when it was staked after follow-up of a BCGS regional stream sediment geochemical survey. Much of the more recent work has been focussed on the South Zone, where drilling between 2017 and 2019 has defined three subparallel zones of low sulphidation epithermal quartz-adularia veining. 2020 saw a significant expansion to these three vein zones. Of most significance is Vein Zone 1, which has now been traced for 4.2km to the Franz showing, uncovered this past summer while prospecting along trend northwest of South Zone. Vein Zones 1 and 3 remain open to the northwest and will be the focus of additional follow-up drilling this year.
